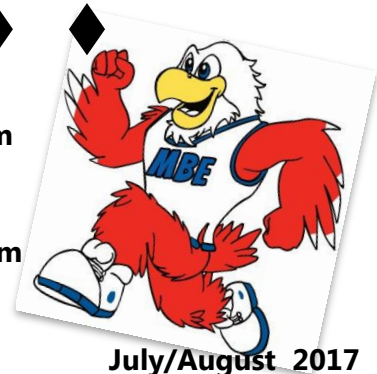

The following is a *generic* school supply list to assist in your summer purchases in preparation for school in the fall. Personal headphones (for use in the Computer Lab) are optional; they need to fit 1/8" jack and be placed in a zip lock bag with name in magic marker.

Kindergarten Suggested Supply List
